

CanPowerSkate Coach Training and Certification Pathway

CanPowerSkate (CPS) COACH

Entry Pre-Requisites:

To attend a CanPowerSkate Coaches Course candidates must:

- be sixteen years of age
- be a Skate Canada associate member
- Figure skating: have completed the NCCP Instruction Beginner CanSkate course or higher;

OR

- Hockey/ringette: have completed the Community Coach Stream (hockey) or the NCCP Community Sport-initiation workshop (ringette).

Please note: These requirements are pre-requisites and must be met prior to attending the course.

Training Requirements:

1. 2-day CanPowerSkate course successfully

Evaluation Requirements for “CanPowerSkate Coach” Status:

1. CPS coach’s exam
2. On-ice practice teaching lesson
3. Emergency Action Plan (EAP) if not already completed successfully in the CanSkate Trained Evaluation Portfolio

The following requirements must be completed prior to registering as a Skate Canada Professional Coach:

- Hold a valid first aid certificate (every three years)
- Complete the Make Ethical Decisions (MED) Online Evaluation: Instruction Stream module which is available at www.coach.ca
- Coaches 18 years of age or older must complete a criminal record check through BackCheck. Coaches who have not reached the age of 18 years at the time of registration will have one month from their 18th birthday to complete the screening.
