### Upcoming events are as follows:

#### Eastern Challenge - December 11<sup>th</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup>.

Sectionals were held in Charlottetown on November 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup>. Rachael MacAulay, Isabelle Keeler, Lindsay Moore, and Ashton Gallant qualified in the Pre-Novice division. Brynne Sinclair-Waters and Chelsey Moore qualified in the Novice division. Niki Pados will be skating in Senior Ladies and Jennifer Parnham will be representing PEI in the Juvenile division. The Merit Award was awarded to Lindsay Moore. The committee chose Lindsay due to the 2 consistent performances she had at Sectionals as well as the way she presented herself with a smile and a “never give up” attitude.

#### Eastern Challenge Qualifiers

Eastern Challenge will be held in Dollard-des-Ormeaux, Quebec this year from **December 11<sup>th</sup> to December 14<sup>th</sup> 2003**. Due to budget constraints, the Skater Development committee will provide \$5000 for the skaters and the parents are fundraising the rest of the money required to cover costs. The parents are selling tickets on a gift basket to be drawn on December 20th.

A Skate to Standard took place on October 30<sup>th</sup> and again at Sectionals. As in the past, only skaters who meet the standard will be funded and they will be given the 2 opportunities to do so. All skaters traveling to Eastern Challenge have met the standard. Thanks to Debbie McMurdo for judging this for us.

Travel arrangements and accommodations have been arranged for skaters, team leaders, and parents. The skaters will leave out of Halifax on December 10<sup>th</sup>. Michelle Coyle is the Team Leader for Eastern Challenge. Cindy Stavert will also assist Michelle. The team will fly back to Halifax on December 14th.
