



2014 FRIENDSHIP SYNCHRONIZED SKATING COMPETITION

The 2014 Friendship Synchronized Skating Competition will be held at Credit Union Place, Eastlink Arena, Summerside, PEI on Sunday, January 5, 2014. An invitation is extended to any affiliated Skate Canada Club to compete in this event, a Skate Canada PEI sanctioned event.

Standard for Coaches: Coaches must have Level 1 NCCP Certification, be a paid Skate Canada member for the current year and have a current First Aid Certificate.

Age Verification: Birth certificates are required. It is recommended that the Team Manager be in possession of the birth certificates to verify the age of a team member in case of dispute. The Team Manager will certify that the dates of birth listed for each team member are correct by signing the List of Team Members and Alternates.

Cancellation of Event: The host committee reserves the right to cancel any event due to insufficient entries.

Registration: Team Managers must register planned program sheet and music upon arrival.

Planned Program Sheet:

Planned Program Sheets must be submitted online no later than one week prior to the event start date, December 27, 2013. TWO paper copies must be submitted upon arrival.

Music: Music will be played from CD's. Two CD's must be submitted at the time of registration. Music should be clearly labeled on the CD as well as the case, indicating the name of the team, the event and music length. CD's should be picked up as soon as possible after the event.

SCORING: Teams will be marked in CPC for their programs and each team will receive a report card. Skill and cheer will be marked in OBO. All marks will be compiled in the OBO system at the end of the event for a final result for each team.

AWARDS: Medals will be presented to the first, second, and third place winners in each category. These placements consist of combined marks from all three events.

SCHEDULE: A schedule will be forwarded to each team manager as soon as possible after the closing date. Such schedule will also be available at www.skatecanadapei.ca and www.ssidefsc.ca

NOTE: There will be a free draw for skating positions done by the host committee and data specialist for each part of this event. This will be done prior to the event and posted in the arena.

EVENTS: There will be three categories of events with all teams participating in all three categories.

CATEGORY 1 – Skills Competition

Teams will take the ice with their coaches, draw from a hat as to what skill they will do (wheel, block, line, circle). Teams will have an opportunity to practice the skill. Each team will be judged on the skill demonstrated. Creativity is encouraged along with lots of team spirit.

CATEGORY 2 – Teams Skate their Competition FreeSkate Program

Beginner I: 8 – 16 skaters, maximum music time 2:10 minutes (program times may be shorter and will receive no penalty). No age limit (recommended skaters working on CanSkate Stage 4 or higher).

Beginner II: 8 – 16 skaters, maximum music time 2:40 minutes (program times may be shorter and will receive no penalty). Skaters must not have reached the age of 12 as of July 1st preceding the competition. At least 75% of the skaters must not have reached the age of 10 as of July 1st preceding the competition.

Elementary: 8 – 16 skaters, maximum music time 2:40 minutes (program times may be shorter and will receive no penalty). Skaters must not have reached the age of 15 as of July 1st preceding the competition. At least 75% of the skaters must not have reached the age of 12 as of July 1st preceding the competition

Juvenile: 8 – 16 skaters, maximum music time 3:10 minutes (program times may be shorter and will receive no penalty). Skaters must not have reached the age of 15 as of July 1st preceding the competition.

Pre-Novice: 8 – 16 skaters, maximum music time 3:10 minutes (program times may be shorter and will receive no penalty). Skaters must not have reached the age of 19 as of July 1st preceding the competition. At least 75% of the skaters must have reached the age of 10 as of July 1st preceding the competition.

Novice: 12 – 16 skaters, 3:30 min program +/- 10 sec. Skaters must have reached the age of 10 as of July 1st preceding the competition. 75% of skaters must not have reached the age of 15, and up to 25% must not have reached the age of 19 as of July 1st preceding the competition.

Intermediate: 12 – 16 skaters, 4:00 min program +/- 10 sec. Skaters must have reached the age of 12 but must not have reached the age of 25 as of July 1st preceding the competition.

CATEGORY 3 - Team Cheer

Teams will perform their team cheer, off ice, and it will not exceed 2 minutes in length. Teams can choreograph their cheer to music of their own choice. Marks will be given for originality, creativity, unison and enthusiasm.
