## Skate Canada Prince Edward Island

## Bylaw 1: Membership

- Skaters wishing to represent Skate Canada Prince Edward Island at a Regional or National level must be approved by Skate Canada Prince Edward Island. This approval can depend on performance level or residency.
- 2. Residency for a skater under the age of 18 years will be determined to exist if at least one of the skater's parents or legal guardians resides in Prince Edward Island. Proof of residency must be provided if requested and will consist of the following:
  - Provincial Health Card
  - Provincial Drivers License; and
  - Federal Tax return showing Prince Edward Island as the province of residence.
- 3. Skaters who have reached the age of 18 years must meet the above residency requirements.
- 4. Skaters moving into the Section will not be permitted to receive any direct funding in the first skating year of their residency. The skating year runs from October 1 to September 30.
- 5. Any skater who represents Skate Canada Prince Edward Island in a regional competition, and subsequently ceases to reside in the province, will be excluded from representing PEI for a period of 1 year from the date residency ceased.
